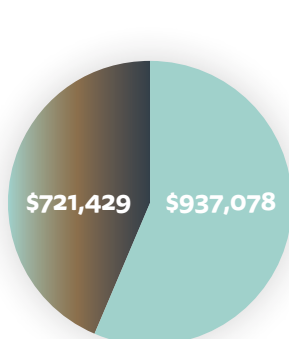

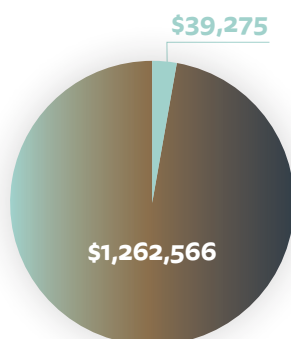

Camp Turner welcomed a record 530 campers for a joyful, faith-filled summer. The 2025 season featured several donor-supported initiatives, including sponsorships of inner-city students from **NativityMiguel Middle School** and four international counselors who enriched the camp experience.

OLV Charities' newest ministry, the **St. Gianna Pregnancy Outreach Center** provides material, emotional, and spiritual support during and after pregnancy to needy mothers and fathers. In 2025, its team assisted 994 families, positively impacting the lives of more than 1,100 children.



The goal of the **Catholic Parenting Initiative**

is to help parents pass their Catholic faith and values onto their children and grandchildren. Among its many successes were its first Family Day that drew more than 400 attendees and its "Drawing God" campaign that engaged 800 students from 20+ diocesan schools.





Through generous donor support, OLV Human Services opened a new **pediatric center**, bringing vital care within walking distance for needy families. The center fills a long-standing healthcare gap, expanding access to primary, preventive, and family-centered services for vulnerable children.

The agency also launched Phase One of its **Victory Learning Center expansion**. Five new classrooms, serving 30 additional students with autism, intellectual disabilities, and mental health challenges, opened. Doing so offered hope to families facing long waitlists and very limited options for care.



In 2025, the **Evaluation & Treatment Center** provided 1,196 multidisciplinary evaluations for children suspected of autism or other developmental disabilities, reducing long wait times and connecting families more quickly to critical therapies and individualized treatment services.



SUPPORTING A PLACE OF PRAYER, WORSHIP, & BEAUTY



Restoration at the Basilica continued on two major fronts. Interior plaster and paint work is stabilizing ceilings, restoring ornamentation, and reviving original colors throughout most of the Shrine. At the same time, dome restoration is replacing century-old copper with durable new sheeting, preserving its iconic silhouette and safeguarding its beauty for generations to come.

The Basilica's **Centennial Celebration**, launched in 2021, entered its final full year in 2025 with concerts, special programming, and community events. Highlights included the June 8 dedication of the beautiful **Father Baker Shrine** located at the humble priest's tomb, painting events inviting artists to capture the beauty of the Basilica, and the **100th anniversary of the first Mass** celebrated on Christmas Day, 1925.



Each year,

thousands of children, teens, adults, seniors, and families come to our campus for help and guidance. Our life-saving programs for those dealing with mental, physical, and behavioral difficulties provide healing and hope. And our wondrous Basilica offers spiritual sanctuary, quiet comfort, and inspiration to visitors.
